CALCUTTA AUCTION 2022 WHAT IS A CALCUTTA AUCTION?

The LIVE Auction portion of tonight's event is the featured highlight of the Cleveland Central Catholic 2022 Calcutta Auction. The auction items are the teams (or the pairings of teams) in the 2022 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. We are challenging you to select, bid on, and buy the team's that you believe will advance the furthest in this year's tournament. This is a progressive game, so the further your team(s) advance(s), the more cash you will win. A payout will be commensurate with the total amount bid through the evening.

Hint: **Plan ahead.** Partner with your friends to create a larger pool of resources to win the bid for your favorite team(s). When the bidding heats up, partner with other buddies. Don't let anyone else get the team(s) you really want – form a betting syndicate with your most savvy basketball friends and pool your funds. That way, you will increase your chances of competing for the most desirable team(s). Good Luck to all the bidders!

Calcutta includes both silent and live auction components.

The winning bids from both the silent and live auctions generate a single pool of money which is then divided as follows: 40% to support the students of Cleveland Central Catholic and the remaining 60% to create a prize pool to be paid to the winning bidders of the teams advancing in the NCAA tournament according to the payout schedule listed in this program.

(A team must advance to each of these rounds to qualify for a payout)

*In the event a team in the first round is forced to withdraw from the tournament, and another team is substituted by the NCAA, and the bidder no longer wants that team/ pairing of teams, they may contact the CCC staff and have their winning bid refunded.

Additional 4% of payouts will be awarded as follows (1% each):

- Team with largest individual game loss margin in round 2 of NCAA Tournament (March 19 and 20 games). Tie-breaker will be awarded to team with higher points scored in its losing game. If still a tie, then the teams with the tying high score will split the winnings.
- Team with largest individual game loss margin in rounds 3 to 7 of NCAA Tournament. Tie-breaker to team with higher points scored in its losing game. If still a tie, then the teams with the tying high score will split the winnings.
- 14-16 seeded team to advance the furthest in the tournament. Tie-breaker would be closest loss in the last round that all surviving teams were eliminated. If still a tie, then teams that tied with closest loss will split the winnings.
- Highest seeded team (e.g., 16 seed being highest) to reach the Final Four. First tiebreaker would be team that advances to final game. If both teams with highest seeds advance to final game then final game winner. If neither teams advance past Final Four games than closest point margin loss in Final Four game.

Our auctioneer is Rob Telecky.

The highest bid acknowledged by the auctioneer wins each item offered. The Calcutta payouts will be made by April 30, 2022.

All bids are final. The Cleveland Central Catholic Calcutta committee has final authority on winning bids and evening activities.

ONLINE SILENT AUCTION RULES

- Silent Auction bidding begins on Wednesday, March 16, 2022 at 12:00 noon, with online bidding and a posted minimum bid amount. Every increase in a bid must be equal to or more than the minimum raise stated in order to be considered a valid bid. At the time of closing, the highest bidder will be declared the winner.
- 2. Online Silent Auction bidding will be closed at 7:15 PM.
- 3. All sales are final and no exchange or refund will be honored by the 2022 Calcutta committee.
- 4. Full payment is required for all auction items before the conclusion of the event. We will accept cash, personal checks, MasterCard, Visa, American Express or Discover cards. Please make your check payable to Cleveland Central Catholic High School.
- 5. Values set forth on auction items are estimates and are not warranted by the 2022 Calcutta committee for tax purposes as competitive market values.
- **6**. In the event of a dispute, auction officials shall act as the final authority and determine the winning bidder(s). Their decision is final.

Q. How do I participate in the Virtual Live Auction?

A. In order to participate in the Virtual Live Auction, you must sign into the Zoom meeting (meeting information). Once signed in, you will be greeted by other bidders and our Auctioneer.

Do I need to be present online to participate in the Virtual Live Auction?

- A. It would be to your benefit to be virtually present because as you are bidding, our auctioneer will be able to see you and announce your bid.
- **Q**. What if I want to participate in the Virtual Live Auction but am unable?
- A. You can always call into the school main phone line and use one of our staff members as your proxy. You can also ask a friend, spouse, coworker, etc. to be your proxy online.


